Reading Together in Foundation Two

Talking about books and stories is one of the best ways of supporting your child to become a great reader. Below there are some questions that you could ask your child after they have finished reading or after you have shared a story together. The questions are linked to the different skills that the children will be learning in class.

- Who are the characters?
- Are the characters good or bad?
- Where was the story set?
- What happened at the beginning/in the end?
- Have a go at retelling the story with three summary sentences - a sentence for the beginning, one for the middle and one the end.
- Did the story have a good or a sad ending? - What makes you think that?
- Did you enjoy the story? Why?
- What was your favourite part? Why?
- Does the story remind you of anything?
- Select a word from the story - what does ... mean?
- Is it a story, poetry or non-fiction (information) book?
